From the Pastor . . .

Dear Church Family,

Happy New Year! Although New Year's Eve and New Year's Day are not originally Christian holidays, they have been celebrated in the church in significant ways. In 1755 John Wesley held the first Covenant Renewal Service. The Covenant Renewal Service has become an important Methodist tradition; it is a time



to remember the past year, reflect on its accomplishments and its failures, and give thanks for the new year with promise and hope. In the Covenant Renewal Service Wesley's Covenant Prayer is recited; that prayer is included in the newsletter today for you to pray.

Over 100 years after the first Covenant Renewal Service, on December 31, 1862, many African-American Christians gathered in churches across the United States for Watch Night Services to celebrate that the Emancipation Proclamation would go into effect on January 1, 1863. That night came to be known as "Freedom's Eve" as people awaited midnight when slaves would be freed across the Confederate States. Ever since then, many churches have celebrated New Year's Eve with Watch Night Services and Covenant Renewal Services, often combining the two.

At our church we begin each Church Council meeting by praying the Covenant Prayer to remind ourselves that we are there to be God's instruments of grace and service. I encourage you to pray this prayer regularly as a reminder of who you are and of whose you are.

The new year is a good time to reflect on the past and plan for the future. This January we will be talking about stewardship in worship. You will hear more information about this in the coming weeks, but I encourage you to begin to be in prayer and conversation about how you and your family can be good stewards of all that God has given you. This week's scripture is Matthew 2:1-12. We are returning to our normal worship times this Sunday, January 7. I look forward to worshipping with you!




