From the Pastor ...

Dear Church Family,

I am writing this shortly after watching the solar eclipse. I was truly awed by the experience of watching the small sliver of the sun disappear into the total eclipse. I was enthralled for all four minutes of totality. I spoke in my sermon about some of the interpretations and theories surrounding the eclipse in



some Christian communities. If you were not in worship, you can watch the sermon on Facebook or YouTube.

The word eclipse comes from the Greek word ékleipsis, which means "abandonment." The ancient Greeks believed that an eclipse meant that the gods were angry at them, and it was a bad omen.

While we do not assign any supernatural meaning to the solar eclipse, it can be a symbolic reminder for Christians. The Gospel of John talks about themes of light and darkness, and in it Jesus proclaims, "I am the light of the world." The eclipse can be a symbolic reminder that when the moon blocks the sun, the sun has not gone anywhere; similarly, God will never abandon us, even when we fail to recognize God's presence with us. I have shared a prayer for the eclipse below, written by my friend, Rev. Elizabeth Henry-McKeever, the priest at St. Michael's Episcopal Church in Little Rock:

Prayer for the Eclipse:

O God of Light, who sets the stars and planets in their courses, thank you for this chance to stand in awe of your creation. Hallow our time of joy, study, and reflection. As we look to the heavens, remind us that your love never abandons us, even when it momentarily fades from our sight. Train our eyes and ears to notice the unexpected gifts present in the midday shadows. In the name of the One who gives light to the world, your Son, Jesus Christ, we pray. Amen.

I hope to see you in worship this Sunday. We will continue to study the resurrection appearances of Jesus with the story of Jesus having breakfast with the disciples and asking Peter if he loves him. This story is found in John 21:1-19.

And the covenant which I have made on


earth,
